Between Mansarovar Dental College Hospital & Research Centre, Bhopal and New Indira Gandhi Convent School, Bhopal.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into force on 07th January 2022 between Mansarovar Dental College Hospital & Research Centre Bhopal, affiliated to Madhya Pradesh Medical Science University, Jabalpur having its campus at Rani Avati Bai Marg, Hinotia Alam, Ward No. 84, Kolar Road, Bhopal – 462042 (M.P.), represented by Principal of Mansarovar Dental College Hospital & Research Centre, Dr. B. Gurudutt Nayak, One Part.

And

New Indira Gandhi Convent School, (Recognised by Govt. of M.P.) located at G-3 Priyanka Nagar, Kolar Road, Bhopal M.P. – 462042 represented by Mr. Vijay Kumar Jhade founder principal of the school the other part.

Here in after collectively also referred to as “parties” and individually as “party”.

This effective upon signing and shall remain in effect for a period of Five Years or until termination by either party with 30 days written notice whichever is earlier. This agreement may also be extended/ modified at the end of the five year after review and need is felt for extension of the agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is designed to reflect the understanding between Mansarovar Dental College Hospital & Research Centre Bhopal, affiliated to Madhya Pradesh Medical Science University, Jabalpur referred herein after the **PARTY OF THE FIRST OF THE FIRST PART** and New Indira Gandhi Convent School, (Recognised by Govt. of M.P.) G-3 Priyanka Nagar, Kolar Road, Bhopal M.P. referred herein after **PARTY OF THE SECOND PART** providing/coordinating services to the school going students and the staff of the concerned school.

ABOUT US:-

Mansarovar Dental College Hospital and Research Centre was established in 2007 by Sri Sai Gramotthan Samiti at Ward 84, Kolar Road, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. New Indira Gandhi Convent School is located at Priyanka Nagar, Kolar Road, Bhopal facilitated with English Medium. This school is progressive movement founded by Mr. Vijay Jhade with a vision to bring about a balanced and harmonious development of students and infuse them with moral values and discipline. New Indira Gandhi Convent School was established the idea of providing services in the field of education. As a result dedication and constant efforts of its founder, the institution has taken several leaps of progress in a short duration of time.

In current times when education is increasingly becoming expensive, the idea of equality in education at minimum expenses is one of the main features of the school.



OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU:-

As for this MOU Mansarovar Dental College will be visiting the New Indira Gandhi Convent School once every three month in a year ,sending a dental team comprising two dentist and five interns. This agreement is made for the benefits of the patients; a large number of patients will be benefited from this MOU.

1. Provide comprehensive dental benefits to all the people residing in the School campus.
2. Screening of oral diseases.
3. Education regarding commonly seen dental diseases like dental caries, periodontal diseases, maligned teeth, non-healing ulcers in mouth.
4. Detection of oral precancerous lesions and conditions
5. All the dental treatment performed in the hospital, 20% discount on all the treatment procedure, except scaling, silver amalgam filling are free of cost.
6. Education regarding effects of systemic diseases on oral health.
7. Education of proper brushing techniques
8. Education regarding importance of proper diet and nutrition on oral health

TERMS OF CO-OPERATION

1. Length of agreement

This memorandum of understanding will remain in force for a period of five years. Participants will abide by the institutional policies, procedures and regulations by which the host party abides and by the local laws.

2. Accountability

An activity report shall be submitted on an annual basis by the designated co-ordinators to each party and appended to this agreement.

3. Amendments

Any amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding will require written approval of each of the party. After the initial five years period, this MOU may be renewed by mutual consent.

4. Termination

Either party reserves the right to terminate this memorandum of understanding upon 30 days written notice. Any program or activity that has already commenced shall be completed to best of both parties' abilities.

5. Language

This agreement is created in duplicates in English, each of those duplicates being deemed original.

6. Signature

Two signed originals of this Memorandum of Understanding will be produced, one to reside with each party



7. This MOU shall not create any legal obligation on either party and a separate agreement shall be entered into between the parties of this MOU in respect of execution of the work agreed under this MOU.
8. Service audit and program review functions shall be performed jointly when appropriate. Both parties mutually agree not to use the name of the other party in any public information without permission of the concerned party.
9. The above MOU is valid for **five years** from the date of signing

Mansarovar dental college and New Indira Gandhi Convent School hereby agree to all of the above and enter into a joint agreement until such time that either party shall amend or review the said agreement in writing.


